

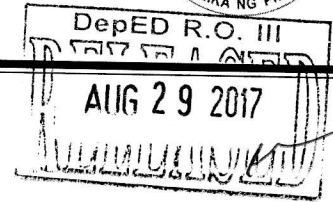
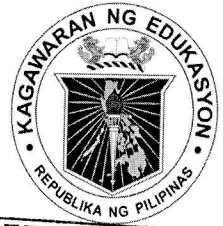

This is to certify that the Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws of

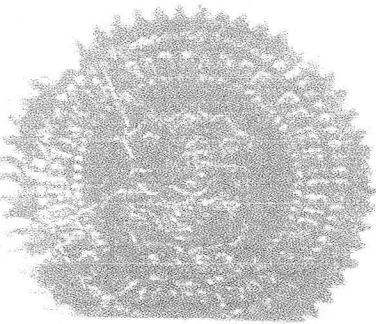
