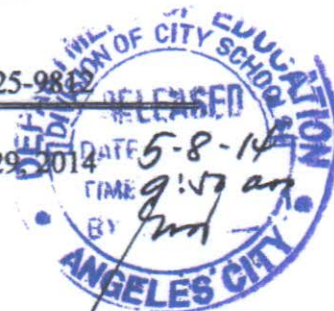

**DIVISION TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON CHILD PROTECTION POLICY**

To: Education Program Supervisors  
Public Schools District Supervisors  
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads  
Faculty Presidents of Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 40, S. 2012 entitled *DepEd Child Protection Policy* which stipulates the Policy and Guidelines on Protecting Children in School from Abuse, Violence, Exploitation, Discrimination, Bullying and Other Forms of Abuse, all public and private elementary and secondary schools shall build the capacities of school personnel, pupils/students and parents to understand and deal with child abuse, exploitation, violence and discrimination cases, bullying and peer violence.
2. In view of the foregoing, this Office will conduct the Division Training-Workshop on Child Protection on May 21-23, 2014 at the Gabaldon Building, Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
3. The objectives of the training are as follows:
  - a. Increase participants' level of awareness on the different measures to protect the child from abuses, exploitation, violence, discrimination and other related cases;
  - b. Capacitate the members of the School Child Protection Committee on how to handle child abuse, exploitation, violence, discrimination cases, bullying and peer violence;
  - c. Formulate School-based Child Protection Policies
4. The participants to the training are 48 principals of public elementary and secondary school heads, 53 faculty presidents, 4 public schools district supervisors, and 5 education program supervisors.
5. A registration fee of P 1,200.00 shall be charged each participant to defray expenses that will be incurred during the training. The amount can be charged from the 5% of the school MOOE which is intended for Gender and Development, subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedure.
6. Participants are requested to register with Mrs. Luzviminda D. Maghuyop, Division Cashier, one week before the training proper from May 12 to May 16, 2014.
7. Attendance of the aforementioned participants is a **MUST**.
8. Wide dissemination and strict compliance to this memorandum is desired.
