**OBSERVANCE OF FILIPINO VALUES MONTH & EsP DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS & VIRTUES**

To: All Heads of Public Elementary, Secondary and Integrated Schools  
 All EsP District and Department Heads/School Coordinators

1. As stipulated in the Presidential Proclamation No. 479 dated October 24, 1994 and in the Enclosure No. 3 to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2015 and DepEd Memorandum No. 177, s. 2017, FILIPINO VALUES MONTH CELEBRATION is observed every November of each year. Relative to these, all schools are mandated to conduct school-based activities in celebration of the Filipino Values Month this November 2019.

2. The theme, details and guidelines of the celebration and various contests for the Festival of Talents and Virtues are stipulated in the Regional Memorandum No. 171, s. 2019 which was sent to the EsP Heroes FB Group. In line with this, there will be District and Division Level contests in preparation for the Regional EsP Festival of Talents & Virtues on November 25-27, 2019. The schedule of the district and division level contests is as follows:

4. All expenses such as meals, transportation, costumes, props, instruments, materials and others related to the contests starting with the school level, district level, division level up to the regional level will be charged against the schools' local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules as stipulated in the section 5 of the Regional Memorandum No. 171, s. 2019.

5. A contribution of one thousand two hundred pesos (P 1,200.00) will be collected from each school chargeable against their local canteen funds to defray expenses during the district and division level competitions such as trophies, medals, certificates, materials, tokens and meals for the judges.

6. A meeting of all the EsP Secondary Coordinators/Department Heads and the four (4) Elementary District Coordinators with the EsP Supervisor will be held on October 11, 2019, 1 P.M. at the Library Hub.
