Contest Guidelines and Mechanics

- 1. Poster Making Contest is a virtual on-the-spot competition. Theme for the contest shall be given on the day of the competition.
- 2. One (1) student-participant per School is allowed.
- 3. Participants must have strong internet connection and must open the Camera during the whole duration of the contest.
- 3. Participants are given 3 hours to finish their outputs.
- 4. Output must be submitted 5 MINUTES after the competition and upload in the google drive provided during the competition.
- 5. File name format should follow POSTER_SCHOOL. (POSTER_ANGELES_ES)
- 6. Student-participant may be accompanied by one coach. However, coaches are only allowed to assist the student during the setting up of materials on the day of the competition
- 7. Participants shall provide $\frac{1}{2}$ size illustration board and must use the white background in vertical background.
- 8. The medium for visual artistry shall only be limited to oil pastel and shall be provided by the contestant.
- 9. Participants are not allowed to bring pictures or images for reference of their entries.
- 10. The poster must be original. If the submitted poster is found to have been plagiarized, it will be disqualified from the competition.
- 11. The contestant and coach of the winning poster will receive a Certificate of Recognition, while a Certificate of Participation will be given for the non-winning participants and coaches.
- 12. The winners will be notified through Division Memorandum.









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- 13. All entries shall be considered property of the DepEd Angeles City and may be used for publication and any other legal purpose.
- 14. Upon joining the contest, student contestants who are over 18 years of age, or their parents, guardians, or caregivers, if they are minors, consent to the use of their personal information as included in the outputs that they will submit for purposes of publication if they be declared as winners, consistent with the provision of the Data Privacy Act.

- 1. Essay Writing (Filipino) Contest is a virtual on-the-spot competition. Theme for the contest shall be given on the day of the competition.
- 2. One (1) student-participant per School is allowed.
- 3. Participants must have strong internet connection and must open the Camera during the whole duration of the contest.
- 4. Participants are given 2 hours to finish their output.
- d. Output must be submitted 5 MINUTES after the competition and upload in the google drive provided during the competition.
- 5. The essay should have a title.
- 6. Participants shall use A4 size bond paper/s.
- 7. Entries should be in Filipino, encoded, double-spaced, with a minimum of
- 1,500 words and maximum of 3,000 words.
- 8. The essay must be original. If the submitted essay is found to have been plagiarized, it will be disqualified from the competition.
- 9. File name format should follow ESSAY_SCHOOL. (ESSAY_ANGELES_ES)
- 10. All entries shall be considered property of the DepEd Angeles City and may be used for publication and any other legal purpose.
- 11. Upon joining the contest, student contestants who are over 18 years of age, or their parents, guardians, or caregivers, if they are minors, consent to the use of their personal information as included in the outputs that they will submit for

purposes of publication if they be declared as winners, consistent with the provision of the Data Privacy Act.

- 6. Videos should be encoded on commonly known video file compressions/formats such as .mp4, .avi, and .mkv.
- 7. Entries must be uploaded to https://bit.ly/GulayVlogEntries on or before 5:00 PM of February 10, 2022.
- 8. File name format should follow GULAYVLOG_SCHOOL. (GULAYVLOG_ANGELES_ES)
- 9. All entries shall be considered property of the DepEd Angeles City and may be used for publication and any other legal purpose.
- 10.
