The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Youth Affairs and Special Concerns-Youth Formation Division (OASYASC-YFD), in partnership with Microsoft Philippines, will conduct a series of **Microsoft Youth Ambassadors (MYA) Initiatives** through a **Capstone Program** on any available days from 1-25 June 2022 via Microsoft Teams.

The MYA program was launched last 30 November 2021, and it aims to shape empowered Filipino students who employ globally competitive skills and embody the ideals of being value-driven, career-oriented, culturally rooted and socially responsible. It also aims to onboard qualified students to serve as the DepEd ambassadors who will champion the innovative use of technology to their classmates and peers.

In the said Capstone Program, the MYAs are expected to conduct their own training to impart basic knowledge on Microsoft 365 applications and communicate effectively to their team members and fellow students to bring out the best possible outputs.

In this regard, the OASYASC-YFD would like to request support and technical assistance from the Regional and Division Offices down to the schools for the conduct of student-led MYA program initiatives as specified in the table below:

Level of Governance	Activities
Regional Office	 The Memorandum issued from the Central Office (CO) shall be disseminated to the different Schools Division Offices (SDOs). MYA-related publication materials shall be shared to regional youth formation social media sites.
Division Office	 The Memorandum issued shall be disseminated to the different schools in the Division. MYA-related publication materials shall be shared to division youth formation social media sites. Through the Youth Formation Coordinators (YFCs), the Division Office shall provide assistance to the MYAs in the identification of schools to be invited to participate in the Capstone Program and shall notify the school head regarding the engagement.
School	 If the school is invited to participate, the School Head, through the SSG teacher-adviser, shall ensure maximum participation of all students from Grades 7 to 12 to participate in the said program. The ICT coordinator of the school shall provide technical support to the MYAs and to all students who wish to participate. MYA-related publication materials shall be shared to the social media sites of the school.
