We hope this very promising International Conference will be highly supported by your office and this promotes our same interests to help our Filipino teachers reach global standards and expertise.

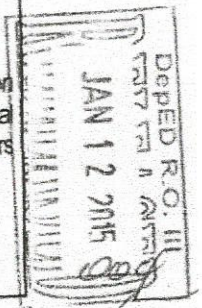
