Astronomy is dynamic and ever-changing. Astronomers around the world are working to further our knowledge. In 2010, we launched an Astronomy Awareness Program nationwide that inspired many students and encouraged them to start reaching for their stars by arousing their interest and curiosity about the wonders and intricacies of the universe and encouraging them to pursue a highly laudable career track in space science and technology.

Now is the perfect time to learn more about the universe as there are lots of space missions and celestial events to look forward to. Conducting this Space Science Strategic Development Program will be beneficial and definitely entertaining for students. We work closely with business, government and academic leaders to develop an initiative that would expand access to state-of-the-art teaching tools, new programs and bolder experiences in bringing Math and Science to life.

The following are the activities for **THE SPACE SCIENCE ROADSHOW** – a totally entertaining, informative and exciting school-based program suitable for all levels from pre-school, elementary and high school.

● **Activity 1: The NCERIES Digital Mobile Planetarium**

A planetarium is an ideal fun environment for children and adults to learn about the Earth and our place in the Solar System. The planetarium is available for hire and is visiting schools nationwide. Every school can now avoid the headache and expense of organizing a fieldtrip to an off-site planetarium. Students experience and enjoy the use of this valuable teaching resource at a minimal cost.

● **Activity 2: Film Showing**

- **Other Activities** (*Provided the sky is clear and the weather is good, the following activities may be held*)



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- ❖ **STARGAZING** – all participants gather at night for the actual observation of the night sky using high-powered telescopes designed to provide optimal viewing experience
- ❖ **SOLAR VIEWING** – participants get to observe the sun using our special solar telescopes
- ❖ **WATER BOTTLE ROCKET MAKING and LAUNCHING** – students enjoy making their own rockets using ordinary water bottles
- ❖ Surprise optional activities like **parlor games, trivia questions about the film, workshops and other exciting events** will surely amaze the students and will make this experience more fun and meaningful to them.

EVENT DURATION

The program runs for approximately **two and a half (2 1/2) hours** per batch (including digital mobile planetarium show, film showing and exhibit/open forum). Students who opt to join the stargazing activity must secure parent's consent and waiver and will have to stay in the venue from 6 P.M. until 9 P.M.

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LARONG BATA (Bullying)

Synopsis:

A bully can think of all kinds of ways to make another person feel hurt, afraid, uncomfortable, or just plain miserable. It can be physical, verbal, or emotional. Often bullies torment a victim over a long period of time, increasing the victim's sense of fear and distress.

The film "Larong Bata" (Bullying) is an omnibus story about family relationship, school violence, physical and verbal abuse. It tells the story of Marlon a pathetic student but excellent in class who is regularly picked-on by his classmates and even cyber-violated by using a cellphone to film the attack. Dessa, a 16-year old girl and a victim of child molestation, is being relentlessly bullied by three of her classmates as she tries hard to improve on herself. Amy, a junior high school student on the other hand is a social climber trying her best to please everyone but ended up being hated and despised. Gelo, an elementary pupil with average skills suffers emotional pain after a series of physical and mental abuse by his classmate and former basketball teammate. One final incident of bullying sends him over the edge and leads him to almost commit an act of violence that stunned the entire school community.

The whole story is presented comically, highly amusing and entertaining for minor audiences but the message of bullying is emphasized and addressed.

Educational Objectives for 'Larong Bata'

1. To provide examples of verbal, physical, and social bullying, as well as cyber-bullying
2. To demonstrate the roles of the perpetrator, the target, and the witnesses in a bullying situation
3. To demonstrate the ways by which people inaction can exacerbate a bullying situation
4. To create understanding and empathy for the target of the child who bullies
5. To inspire the victims of bullying to become more dynamic and encourage positive consequences.
