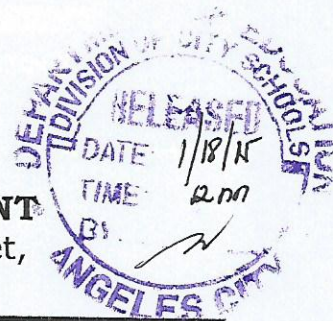

This seminar aims to:


1. Identify interdisciplinary techniques and practices ;

Attached herewith are advisory and invitation of the training issued by DepEd Central Office for your reference.




