Poster / Painting / Photo Contest Mechanics

The contest is open to the following levels

1. Grade school (grades 5-6)

2. High school students (junior & senior)

College level or Out of School Youth

Each participant should submit ONE entry, per competition

(painting/poster/photo)

Registration Fee: Individual - P150 (one hundred fifty pesos)

Per School / University / Institution - P1.500 (one thousand five hundred pesos)

with maximum of 30 participants / contestants

The poster / painting / photo must capture , illustrate, interpret and emphasize the five dignity principles of Global Dignity Organization:

Every human being has the right to lead a dignified life.

2. A dignified life means having the opportunity to fulfill one's potential, which requires an adequate level of health care, education, income and security.

3. Dignity means having the freedom to make the decisions governing one's own life, and to have this right respected by others.

Dignity should be the basic guiding principle for all actions.

5. Ultimately, our own dignity is interdependent with the dignity of others.

The following materials will be used in the contest: (all art materials will be provided by the contestant)

Poster size 18X24 inches or 48x61 cm illustration board (white background & vertical format)

Painting Canvass size 24X36 inches or 61x91 cm (white background & vertical or horizontal format)

Pencil, Brushes and Coloring materials: oil pastel / Cray-pas, markers, ink, mixed media, oil, acrylic and watercolor.

Photo Competition : Any camera Photo Size 8R size, color print, unmounted and must submit a JPEG Format File with a minimum size of 1MB in a Compact Disk (CD) copy.

What Photo should be submitted:

 Photographs must have been recently shot (2016). • For a photo in which a person is recognizable, the photographer is responsible for securing permission from that person or, in the case of a minor, from the subject's parent or guardian.

The following photographs are disqualified:

- Photographs that are digitally or otherwise enhanced or altered for creative purposes. Altered Images refer to Photographs manipulated and applied with special effects (colorizing, toning, collage, photo composites, HDR, etc.). However, minor adjustments, including sharpening, contrast and slight color adjustment or the digital equivalents, are acceptable
- A Photographs that have been submitted to or won in any other contests or have been published in print or online.
- oxtimes Photos that violate another person's rights, including but not limited to copyright.
- Photos which are highly immoral, relatively obscene and/or in violation of public moral and/or public policy.

All Entries must be done and submitted on the DATE and VENUE of the the competition. Posters and Paintings must be done in free hand and be officially submitted to The EVENT FACILITATOR.

The artist will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design. All entries will be exhibited after the contest and during the duration of the Global Dignity Celebration this October 2016. All photos submitted shall become properties of the GLOBAL DIGNITY ORG.- PHILIPPINES.

* By joining the contest, the entrant is considered to have granted the GLOBAL DIGNITY ORGANIZATION - PHILIPPINES permission or license to use the photos, along with the names of the photographers, for various publications and marketing collaterals of the GDO, and for other purposes.

The top three (3) entries (regional) will be chosen to be exhibited to the national level, and all finalists will receive Certificates of Participation and one thousand pesos each (P1,000)

GRANDFINALS Prizes and Incentives:

- First Prize: Cash Prize of Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000) and a framed Certificate
- Second Prize: Cash Prize of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000) and a framed Certificate.
- Third Prize: Cash Prize of Two Thousand Five Hundred (P2,500) and a framed Certificate.
- Consolation prizes: One Thousand Pesos (P1,000) and a framed Certificate each for the other ten chosen photos.
