Module for Afternoon Session:

Time	Activity	Description / Objective
1:00 – 1:20	Energizer	A big group activity that would promote camaraderie and rapport among the participants and trigger their values of unity and leadership.
1:20 – 2:00	Realization	An eye – opener session through viewing of different documentary videos regarding juvenile delinquency and child crime.
		Small group discussion will be facilitated after every video to establish the knowledge, views and opinions of the student leaders regarding the topic.
2:00 – 2:40	Interaction	An open debate regarding the specific, hot topics rose during the small group discussions. To let the student leaders express their views in a larger crowd and gain confidence in speaking to the public while gaining more knowledge about juvenile delinquency.
2:40 – 3:15	Call for Action	To let the students decide on what actions or activities can they propose or conduct together with the assistance of the Trending Leaders to reduce if not totally eradicate the increasing incidence of juvenile delinquency.
3:15 - 3:30	Presentation	Present in a Creative Way the proposed action
3:30 – 4:00	Commitment Setting	To let the student leaders have an opportunity to make their commitment on how to reduce if not totally eradicate the increasing incidence of juvenile delinquency.
