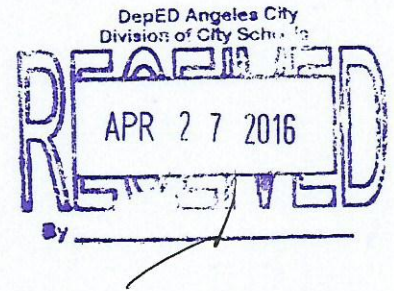
SUBJECT : **Early Childhood Education Conference**



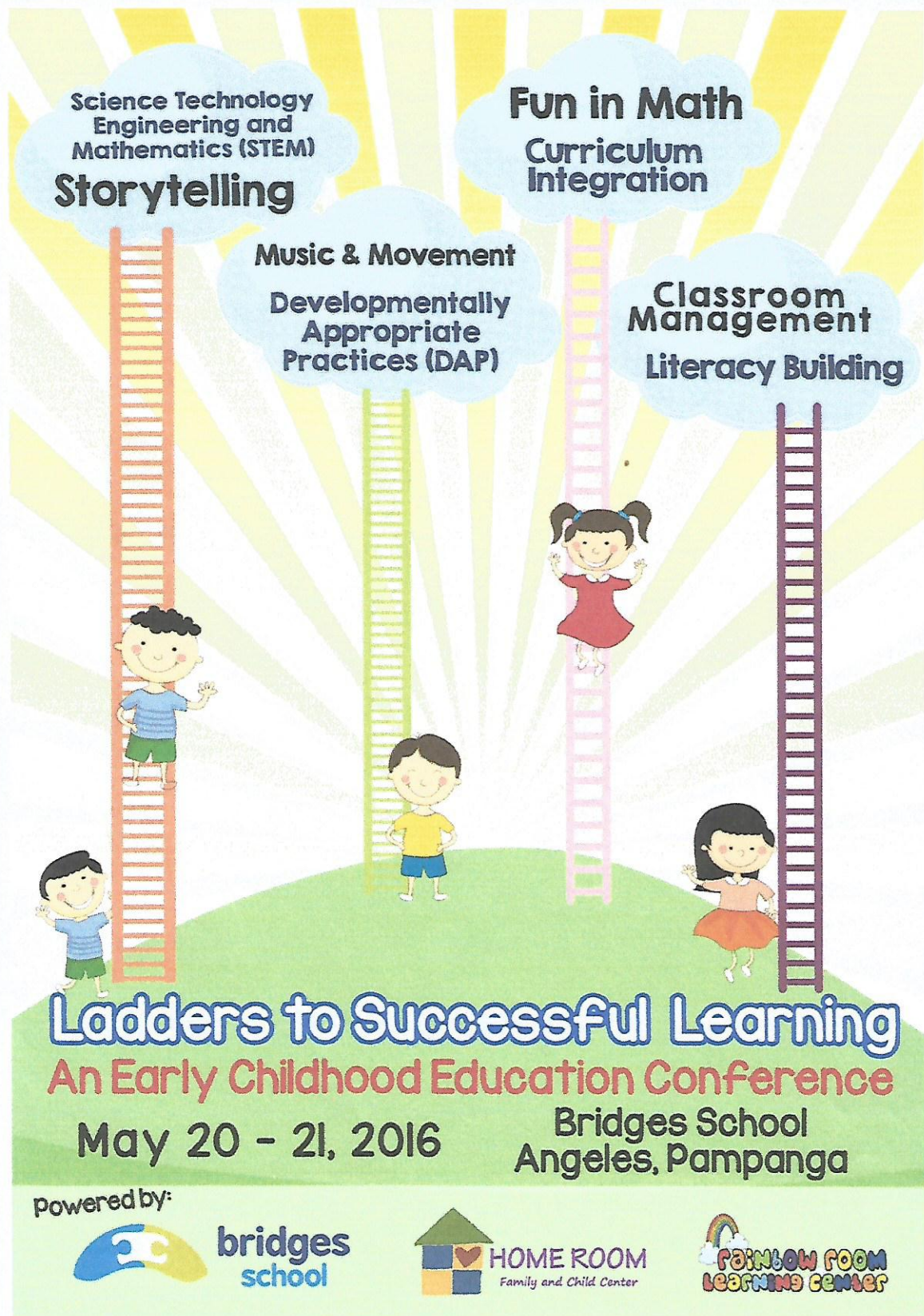
