The Citizen's Disaster Response Center Inc., is a non-stock non-profit non-government organization duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission. It is accredited by the Department of Social Welfare and Development as a social development agency with the mandate to carry-out community-based disaster management activities throughout the country.

As a part of its advocacy to create and raise awareness of disaster preparedness, CDRC has been conducting an annual poster-making contest for children entitled "APOY, BAGYO, KALAMIDAD: DIBUHONG PAMBATA (ABKD)"

This year, CDRC is once again inviting children 7 to 12 years old to participate in the contest which aims to generate children's perspective on disaster preparedness through artworks. ABKD is divided into two categories. Category A is open to children ages 7-9, where they are expected to express ideas on preparedness on any of the following subjects: typhoon or floods, volcanic eruption or lahar, earthquake, fire, landslide and damage to the environment brought about by mining, logging and other development project. Category B is for children ages 10-12. Artworks under this category should focus on any of the following subjects: drought, red tide or fish kill, infestation, outbreak of diseases or epidemic, armed conflict and climate change.

Artworks in any medium should be drawn on a ¼ illustration board must bear a title and a caption and submitted together with the contestants name, age, address, telephone number, school's name and grade level.
