

# SA AKING KABATA YOUTH CAMP ON ARTS, HERITAGE AND ENVIRONMENT

The Arts Research and Training Institute in Southern Tagalog, Incorporated (ARTIST, Inc.) will launch a project entitled "Sa Aking Kabata: Youth Camp on Arts, Heritage and Environment" in collaboration with ARTIST-Production Accessories and Resource Services (ARTIST-PARS) Association Incorporated and National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) on August 2-5, 2017 at the University of the Philippines, Los Baños.

SA AKING KABATA was the title of the short poem written by Jose Rizal when he was a child. Entitled SA AKING KABATA, this project is a 4-day camp that aims to enhance the youth's awareness on heritage conservation and management.

The components of the project include lecture-forum on culture and heritage and mapping, workshop-demonstration on combined performing arts, visual literary and media arts, heritage tours and community interactions.
