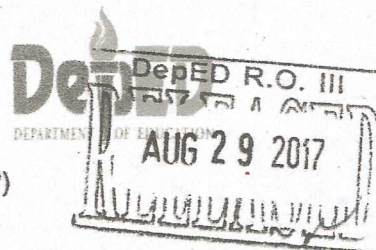

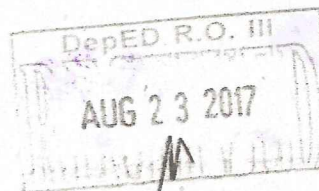

2017 MILO LITTLE OLYMPICS ELIGIBILITY RULES

The MILO Little Olympics competition is open to all bona fide students in Elementary and Secondary Division of the official list of participating schools.

a. Elementary students must compete in the Elementary Division only. The age limit for Elementary athletes is from 7 to 12 years old. The cut-off year of which is the year 2005.

b. Secondary students must compete in the Secondary Division only. The age limit for Secondary athletes is 16 years old. The cut-off year is 2001.

2. Student-athletes found to have violated the Eligibility Rules shall be prohibited from participating in all future MILO events. The player forfeits his/her standing in the individual events or in case of team events, his/her team forfeits all games he/she had played on.

3. The Event Organizer also reserves the right to disqualify any school which commits any act detrimental to the MILO Little Olympics.

4. The Event Organizer reserves the right to accept or deny participants, and modify any of the above rules and regulations, as it deems necessary to ensure the success of the MILO Little Olympics.
