SUBJECT: **POSTPONEMENT OF THE AFORESAID CAPACITY BUILDING ACTIVITIES DUE TO THE FOLLOWING REASONS:**

- Unavailability of the resource speakers
- Conflicting schedules from the health offices and some schools

NEXT STEP:

- Considering the HIV prevalence, sites will include and expand as follows: Angeles City, City of San Jose del Monte (Bulacan), Mabalacat City, Meycauayan City, Olongapo City, and Balanga City, among other priority sites.
- Local AIDS Councils of the respective local government units (LGUs) will create a Core Team (4 slots: 2 slots from the Health Offices and 2 slots from the Division Offices) to be capacitated for the Training of Trainers (TOT) for HIV and STIs Education in School Setting on May 30, 2017-June 1, 2017 at Eurotel Hotel, Angeles City.
- Invitation letters for the TOT of the LGUs will originate from the DOH-Regional Office III and the information to the core team shall be disseminated through them.
- After the trainers' training, local roll-out capacity building activities shall ensue and scheduled per convenience of the division offices (June-July 2017). Schedule for the roll out will be reiterated to DepEd-Regional Office III for approval.
