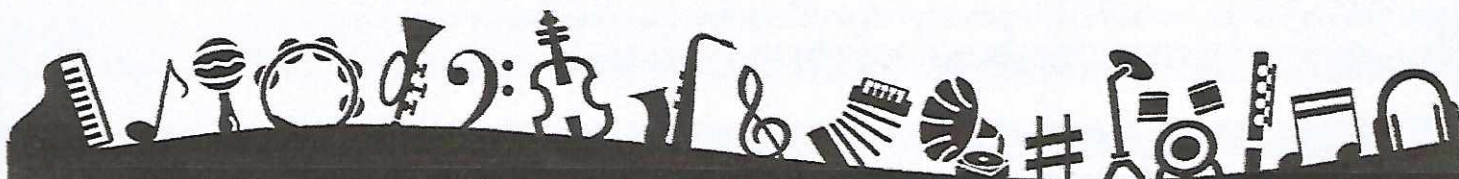

The Environmental Song Writing Competition is open to all interested participants (novice, amateur and professional songwriters residing in National Capital Region, Region 3 (Central Luzon) and Region 4-A (Calabarzon) only. Employees of EMB Central Office, including their relatives up to the second degree of consanguinity, are disqualified from joining the competition.

Environment Month is celebrated yearly, in June. Its objective is to provide awareness and exposure to the Filipino people on the need for environmental conservation and preservation. The eventual outcome of this is geared towards sustainability of our eco-friendly and economically stable communities.

Particularly in June 2018, an Environmental Song Writing Competition will be an important focus of the celebration of Environment Month in the Philippines. This Environmental Song Writing Competition is open to all interested participants (novice, amateur and professional songwriters) in NCR, Region 3 and Region 4-A.

I. CONTEST MECHANICS:

1. The song composition must be the original composition of the participants (lyrics/message, musical arrangement), but choice of appropriate genre such as Pop, Jazz, Ballad, Classical, Soul, Blues, R&B, Gospel, except Metallic, Rock, Hip Hop and Rap.
2. Themes of songs must revolve around the theme of "environmental- related topics, environmental protection, conservation and preservation."
3. The lyrics of the song must be in English, Filipino or a combination of both ("Taglish"). One or a combination of musical instruments may be used.
4. Song entries must not exceed four (4) minutes, including intro and extro. Entries must be submitted in full accompaniment version and in minus-one.
5. The song entry must not have been used in any previous competitions or commercially released (i.e., recorded and commercially distributed, sold to the public or uploaded in any online/social media platforms).
6. Words with registered trademarks/brand names, explicit and offensive lyrics, are strictly not allowed.
7. All song entries (musical composition/arrangement) shall be considered FINAL once submitted. and cannot be

2. Song lyrics should be printed in Microsoft word Document, sent along together with the ff:

a) Name of sender (e.g. composer(s), lyricist(s) and/or arranger(s))

b) Age

c) Contact numbers

d) E-mail address with 1 (one) 2x2 picture to be submitted through courier service to: *(please see back page)*

3. CD, lyric sheets, and other requirements submitted to EEID-EMB are returnable, EXCEPT for the song entries that are qualified in the competition so that the copyrights over them, shall automatically be assigned by the contestant in favor of EMB for, a period of ten (10) years from the date the said entries were submitted in the Competition.

III. SCREENING OF ENTRIES:

1. Pre-selection of winning entries will be done one-month (tentatively on May 17, 2018) before the designated date of Environment Month celebration;
2. The 10 Winning entries, who will showcase their original song composition either by the compositor or their interpreter, live during the Environmental Music Festival, will be notified through their e-mail addresses. The venue, time and date, will be identified later. The ranking of the winners (Champion, 1st, 2nd, 3rd runners- up, and consolation prizes) will be announced after the live performances. Aspecial award for the Best Performer will also be awarded.
3. A Board of Judges for the competition will be organized, whose decision shall be final and un-appealable.

IV. CRITERIA FOR JUDGING:

The following are the criteria for judging to determine the winning environmental songs.

Key Factors Percentage

1. Lyrics/Impact of the message	=	50 %
2. Voice Quality	=	25 %
3. Musicality	=	15 %
4. Originality (composition)	=	10 %

Total = 100 %
