

Dear Ms. Cunanan:



On June 15, 1991 the nation was shocked by the eruption of what seemingly was a dormant volcano. Mt. Pinatubo's eruption left 800 bodies in its wake and hundreds of thousands homeless. Recorded as the second largest eruption of the 20th century, it is also remembered as the largest eruption to affect a densely populated area.

25 years later the province of Pampanga is recognized as one of the most prosperous province in the country despite being one of the major provinces that felt the devastation wrought by the Mt. Pinatubo eruption.

The national government has recognized the need to render appropriate tribute to those who perished, as well as to those who survived and to those who helped in the relocation, rehabilitation and recovery of Pinatubo affected families through Proclamation 500. The Proclamation declares June 15, 2018 as a special non-working holiday in the City of Angeles, Pampanga.

In line with this may we request the honor of your presence to attend the Commemoration of Mt. Pinatubo on June 15, 2018 (Friday), 2:00PM onwards at Abacan Loop, Balibago. We would also like to request the presence of the other officials, supervisors, principals, social studies teachers and students under your division to grace the occasion.
