Title	Description
<i>Supremo Redux, Isang Musikal sa Bahay ni Bonifacio</i>	A three-act musical about the life and sacrifices of Andres Bonifacio
<i>Obra ni Juan, The Musical</i>	The life and story of Filipino painter and sculptor Juan Luna, as well as the struggles of Filipino heroes like Antonio Luna and Jose Rizal during the Spanish colonial rule
<i>Rain: Reinventing Anthology of Individual Narratives</i>	A collection of three original one act plays recognized by the Palanca Memorial Awards
<i>Ang Locomotor</i>	The Filipino adaptation of Nick Joaquin's A Portrait of the Artist as Filipino
