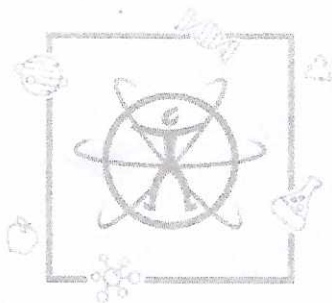

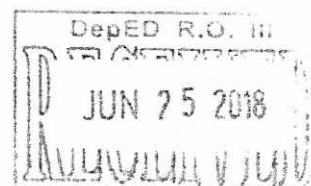

SUMMER CAMP (NYSTESC)**

The Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC), Inc. will conduct the **2018 National Youth Science, Technology, and Environment Summer Camp (NYSTESC)** with the theme, **"CON[FIGURE]: Hustle. Thrive. Survive."**, from July 26 to 29, 2018 in D'Leonor Inland Resort and Adventure Park, Forestal Rd., Buhangin, Davao City.

The Conference aims to:

1. provide the participants with a thorough understanding of the concepts and impact of Aerodynamics, this year's selected ST&E topic, and its multi-disciplinary fields through interaction with experts in the field;
2. provide a venue for the exchange of ideas and promotion of camaraderie among junior high school science club members and their teachers as well; and
3. encourage more students to join science clubs and to be involved with their teachers in the science clubbing movement.

The target participants are **enrolled junior high school science club members (Grades 7-10), senior high school science club members (Grades 11-12), and their respective advisers** from both public and private schools nationwide.

The deadline for submission of registration requirements is on or before **July 6, 2018, Friday**, together with the **complete list of participants** per school or science club. **Beyond this date, participants who are not on the list will not be covered with insurance.**

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
