Education link as suggested by the Award's name includes existing initiatives in educational cooperation which have proven to be effective and beneficial to Southeast Asia and Australia. It can also be proposals or innovative ideas which carry the potential in improving education in the region. Projects and proposals may include event organizations, academic or student exchanges, an education or research development programmes, and other activities.
