

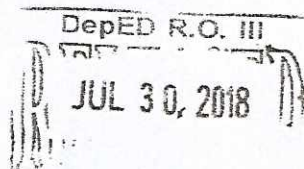

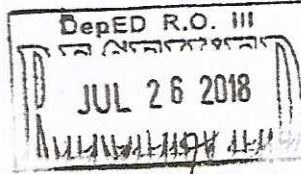

## CLAPSA LIVE-IN SEMINAR-WORKSHOP FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL TEACHERS FOCUSED ON INTEGRATING TECHNOLOGY FOR MEANINGFUL LEARNING

**To: *School Divisions Superintendent

1. A Regional Seminar-Workshop for Private School Teachers will be conducted on **August 31 and September 1, 2018** by the Central Luzon Association of Private School Administrators, Inc. (**CLAPSA**), in partnership with the Continuing Education for the Learning Professionals, Inc. (**CELPI**), and in coordination with the Department of Education RO III.
2. This two-day **live-in** seminar workshop which will be held at **Hacienda Gracia, Sta. Maria, Lubao, Pampanga** is designed to equip the participants with the pedagogical knowledge and skills in integrating technology for meaningful learning;
3. Upon completion of this training, the participants will gain two advantages, first, they will earn **15 CPD units** and second, they will know and be able to do the following:
  - a. communicate with confidence technology integration in the learner-centered paradigm.
  - b. select, evaluate and integrate technology in the delivery of content
  - c. create learning activities to show the bridging of pedagogy with technology
  - d. demonstrate technology integration using various educational Apps and other Web instructional resources.
4. Registration fee in the amount of **Php. 2,800.00** shall be charged each participant and it shall cover seminar kit, and board and lodging for one night. Select publications have volunteered to subsidize payment for the CPD units of the participants to CLAPSA'S program provider, CELPI (PRC Accredited CPD Provider for Professional Teachers).
5. **ONLY THE FIRST THREE HUNDRED (300)** registrants will be accommodated and the **NO WALK-INS** policy will be strictly followed.



6. On-line prepaid registration on a "first come-first served" basis will likewise be implemented.
