

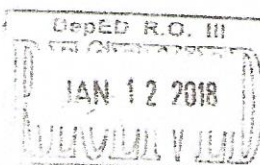

The training – workshop will focus on the following areas:


- Understanding and Enhancing Children's Speech and Language Skills
