

1. There shall be separate contests for elementary and high school (combined Junior High School &

Senior High School) levels.

2. A school may enter a maximum of TWO contestants only per individual category.

3. A participant can attend in ALL lectures but can join in a maximum of TWO individual contests only and ONE group contest only.

4. The individual contests for both elementary and high school (combined Junior High School & Senior High School) levels shall have the following categories both in English and in Filipino.

- 5. For photojournalism, digital cameras shall be used. Blank or empty memory cards shall be submitted to the Secretariat before the actual photo shoot for checking.
- 6. For Radio Broadcasting and TV Broadcasting (English and Filipino):
 - There shall be separate competitions for elementary and high school (combined Junior High School & Senior High School) levels.
 - Each team shall be composed of seven (7) members.
 - The first part of the competition is scriptwriting which shall be prepared using laptops, extension cords, and printers brought by the participants/every team. The second part shall be the actual broadcast.
 - The campus journalists shall simulate a 5-minute radio broadcast. Two minutes shall be allotted for entrance and exit.
- 7. For Collaborative Desktop Publishing (English and Filipino):
 - 7.1 There shall be a separate competition for elementary and high school (combined Junior High School & Senior High School) levels.
 - 7.2 Each participating school shall organize a team of seven (7) members.
 - 7.3 Once the contest has started, members of each team shall no longer be allowed to go back to their quarters nor report to their respective advisers.
 - 7.4 The team will be given two (2) hours for data gathering and writing and another two (2) hours for lay-outing and editing.

- 7.5 Each team will be required to bring a maximum of (4) laptops installed with Microsoft Publisher for elementary and Adobe In-Design for high school, to lay-out the group's final output. They are also required to bring extension cords and printers per team. The laptops will be checked by the Grub Street Secretariat for any other official applications and prewritten documents or references therein.
- 7.6 Mobile phones and other electronic gadgets shall not be allowed except for digital camera and laptops with disabled internet connection.
- 7.7 Each group will be required to convert their output into pdf, print, and submit it to the contest committee.
- 7.8 The output of the contest is an A4-size four-page publication.
- 7.9 The decision of the evaluator/s shall be deemed final and irrevocable.
- 8. IMPORTANT: Confirmation of attendance is on or before August 31, 2018 (Friday). - The top five (5) winners shall be recognized in every category. The top three (3) winners will receive medal and a certificate of recognition. Meanwhile, the other two winners will receive certificate of recognition.

As exhibition events, school standings in the Essay Writing (both English and Filipino), Column Writing (both English and Filipino), Poetry Writing (both English and Filipino), Developmental Communication (both English and Filipino), TV Broadcasting, Campus Journalism Quiz Challenge (elementary level), and Campus Journalism Quiz Challenge (high school level) shall not be added to the overall ranking.
- 12. Back-to-back capacity seminars are also prepared for school paper advisers of elementary schools, junior, and senior high schools.
- 13. Subject to the recommendation of the evaluators, winning outputs will get a chance to be published in the list of Grub Street's best.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

2nd Elementary Campus Journalism Quiz Challenge 4th High School Campus Journalism Quiz Challenge

- 1. The competition is open separately to elementary and high school (combined Junior High School & Senior High School) students only.
- 2. For participating schools with less than 10 attendees, only one team composed of three students will
- 3. For participating schools with more than 10 attendees, one team for every 10 participants will be
- 4. The quiz challenge shall include questions from the history of journalism, legal bases of campus journalism, news writing, editorial writing, features writing, sports writing, editorial writing, editorial cartooning, science & health writing, copy reading & headline writing, essay writing, column writing, poetry writing, developmental communication, photojournalism, radio broadcasting, TV broadcasting, collaborative desktop publishing, and local & international current events.
- 5. There will be three (3) components in the competition namely: elimination/easy round, semifinal/average round, and the final/difficult round.
- 6. The easy round has 10 questions worth 2 points each, the average round has 10 questions worth 3 points each, and the difficult round has 10 questions worth 5 points each.
- 7. The questions will be read by the quiz master twice.
- 8. After the second reading, the quiz master shall say "go", only then the groups be allowed to write their answers. Automatically, the 10 second time-limit will begin with the word "go" by the quiz
- 9. After the time-limit, the contestants must stop writing and must raise their answer boards.
- 10. Only the contestants in the designated quiz room/s can make a protest.
- 11. Any protest shall be brought to the attention of the Panel of Examiners immediately—that is before the next question is read. Otherwise, it will no longer be entertained.
- 12. The decision of the panel of examiners is final and irrevocable.
