

Attached is a letter from Mr. Jose Cecilio U. Pascual, Director, Gesu Development Center, for reference and information.

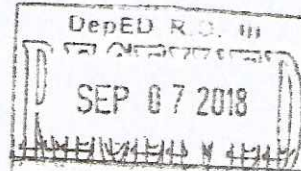

We had been offering this program in Quezon City and in Vigan, Ilocos Sur where 12.5 CPD units were granted by the PRC for each run.
