
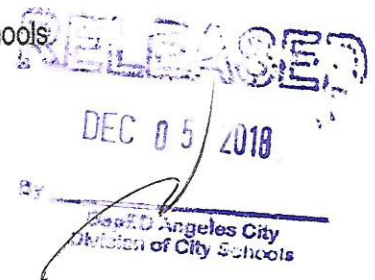

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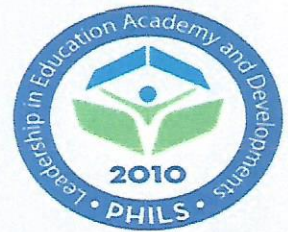

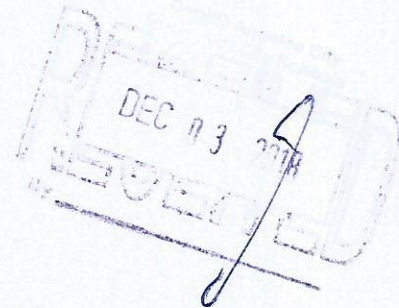

This seminar will be given 24 contact hours, equivalent CPD units and a DepEd Advisory which will be sought from your office.

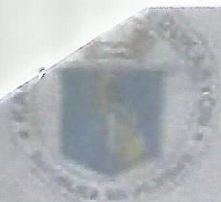
