
Blessings to you!

We are the Philippine Society for Music Education, a non-stock, non-profit, SEC registered organization of music educators in the Philippines. For the past 45 years, the PSME has been training music teachers in elementary and the high school level in content and pedagogical knowledge of music in the curriculum. Recently, we provided technical advice and input during public hearings on PSG's on the bachelor in music major in music education by the Commission on Higher Education Technical Panel on the Humanities Music committee last November 2017.

In this regard, we are asking your office for the issuance of a local advisory that will enable teachers from your region to attend our music education training workshop entitled, "Contextualizing Music Education in the K+12 Curriculum" this April 6, 7, and 8, 2018 at the Abelardo Hall, College of Music, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City. The objective of the workshop is to engage the current music education curriculum in the basic education levels through training sessions in basic musicianship, classroom music teaching strategies, playing recorder, bamboo instruments, and functional guitar/keyboard, as well as singing/conducting techniques. Possible participants include school music teachers and instructors of music or culture and art education in teacher training institutions. A workshop fee of Php4,000 includes a kit, certificates, and lunch for three days.
