

The Arts Research and Training Institute in Southern Tagalog, Incorporated (ARTIST Inc.), ARTIST-PARS Association Inc. and Lusong Luzon Arts and Culture Network Inc. in cooperation with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) and Department of Education (DepEd) will launch the SANAYSINING ARTS SCHOOL Kapnayan at Hulmahan sa Sining at Dulaan on May 7-12, 2018 at the University of the Philippines Los Banos, Laguna.

SANAYSINING aims to provide artists, cultural workers, teachers, educators and community organizers comprehensive training on the techniques related to their field of teaching and specialization. Specifically, its objective is to equip participants with the capability to facilitate and produce creative outputs, curate performances, mount exhibits, utilize different approaches in providing artistic and organizational guidance towards the intended output of their students

SANAYSINING is open to artists, cultural workers in the communities and teachers of Special program for the Arts, Arts and Design Track, MAPEH, Filipino, Literature, advisers of student clubs and people engaged in handling related subjects.

The short courses to be offered are the following:

1. SANAYSANAY. Trainers' Training in Arts

A short course intended for teacher-artists and/or art practitioners as trainers of different genre of arts. Discussions and hands-on activities will focus on developing and implementing arts

2. MANDUDULA . Playwriting & Directing for Theatre and Film.

A short course focusing on writing and directing a stage play and short film production. Discussions and exercises will cover the rudiments and principles of playwriting and directing.

3. SINING MAKIPAMUHAY. Literature, Arts, and Immersion in the Region

A short course intended for teachers of Contemporary Philippine Arts from the Region, Literature in the 21st Century and System Management on Work Management.

4. DULAMBATA. Training for Pre-school Teachers

A short course aimed in developing the creative skills of teachers and artists in pre-school education. Participants will experience hands-on exercises on developing action-songs, storytelling and production of visual arts materials.

5. GALAW-KORYO. Dance and Choreography

A short course intended for dancers and choreographers. Sessions include discussions and activities on applying the rudiments and principles of dance composition and choreography.

6. TANGHAL-HIMIG. Music Composition

A short course aimed in honing the skills of the participants in music production. Sessions include discussions and hands-on activities on the rudiments and principles of lyrics writing and
