

REGARDING THE BRIGADA ESKWELA SA  
MARAWI BATCH 2 and 3 IMPLEMENTATION**

In light of the signed memorandum circular dated 21 February 2018 regarding the implementation of the Brigada Eskwela sa Marawi Batch 2 and 3, there are changes to specific details of the previous memorandum due to procurement concerns thereby limiting the number of participants for batches 2 and 3. For this purpose, the following details are advised:

1. Change of schedule of batch 2 has been provided through an advisory dated 23 March 2018 (see Annex A);
2. 17 schools will participate in the BESM Batch 2 as well as Batch 3 (see Annex B.1 and Annex B.2 for the list of schools for the BESM Batch 2 and 3, respectively, along with the twin/pair regions and divisions of the said schools);
3. Participants:
  - a. Required:
    - i. All regional (RO) and division (DO) DRRM Coordinators and Engineers of Mindanao regions

including ARMM who are assigned as pairs/twins of the aforementioned 17 schools;


- ii. Maximum of five (5) skilled manpower per Mindanao pair/twin DO concerned;
  - iii. RO and all DO DRRM Coordinators and Engineers of NCR (batch 3 only);
  - iv. Schools Division Superintendents (SDS) and Assistant SDSs of Marawi City Division along with the school heads of the aforementioned 17 schools and other schools that will be cleared to open classes; and,
  - v. DRRMS personnel.
- b. Invited:
- i. SDSs and Regional Directors (RD) of twin/pair Mindanao ROs and DOs;
  - ii. Eight (8) representatives from the Youth Formation Division of the Central Office; and,
  - iii. Updated list of select Disaster Control Group (DMG) members, Baguio Teachers' Camp personnel, and Administrative Service personnel (see Annex C).
4. It is reiterated that all details in the previous memorandum that have not been mentioned in this current memorandum is still deemed applicable and unchanged.

In light of the implementation of the Brigada Eskwela sa Marawi (BESM) Batches 2 and 3, the following changes are adopted due to the discussions and issues raised by Regional Directors and Schools Division Superintendents in the various 2018 Budget Execution and 2019 Budget Preparation Workshops conducted:

1. BESM Batch 2 will be moved from April 2-7 to April 9-14, 2018, of which April 9 and 14 shall be considered as the travel time while the actual conduct of the BESM will be on April 10-13;
2. BESM Batch 3 remains to be scheduled on April 23-28 as originally stated in the memorandum circular with April 23 and 28 designated as the travel time and April 24-27 designated as the actual BESM implementation period;
3. A BESM Closing Ceremony and launching of Oplan Balik Eskwela sa Marawi (OBESM) will be conducted on May 22-23, the details of which will be provided in another memorandum circular; and,

4. BESM Batches 2 and 3 will be low key events, while BESM Closing and OBESM Launching will be media events with Secretary Leonor Magtolis Briones, Executive Committee Members, and Management Committee Members.
