The speakers in the event will share their technical expertise to provide updated content knowledge, teaching strategies, and demonstration tools in teaching the subject to High School students. They will be coming from the University of the Philippines Resilience Institute and NOAH Center (previously known as Project NOAH).

Since the ratification of Republic Act (RA) 10121 or the Disaster Management Act of 2010, mainstreaming Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) in education has been implemented through Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 37, Series of 2015. DRR education is also specifically integrated through a specialized subject called Disaster Readiness and Risk Reduction. Numerous government and academic institutions have also updated many of their existing efforts to empower the public to become aware and knowledgeable of the risks that disasters pose. The UP Resilience Institute (UPRI) in 2017 continued one of the country's flagship DRRM programs, the Nationwide Operational Assessment of Hazards (Project NOAH) and reiterated the need for disaster data and information to be free and accessible especially during emergencies. In light of these developments and new breadth of publicly accessible scientific information and ongoing efforts of the different sectors in DRR, we see the great potential in the exchange of best practices and knowledge in DRR for the enhancement of capacity and resilience through education.
