Fellowships are granted competitively to candidates with a commitment to public service in both the public and private sectors. The program is designed to meet the requirements of policy makers, planners, and managers who have a public service orientation, are committed to their country's development, and have demonstrated leadership potential.

The Humphrey program is not intended for technicians, research-oriented professionals, or faculty members with no administrative or managerial functions. Candidates should be mid-career professionals committed to public service and should have demonstrated ability to achieve positions of significant responsibility and have the promise of assuming future leadership roles.
