



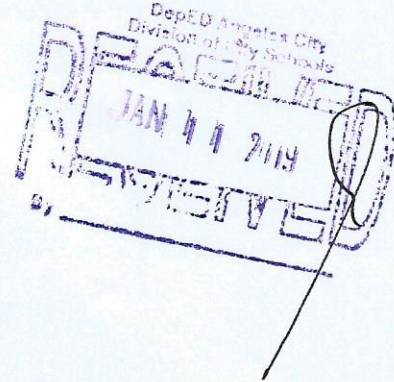

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### National Arts Month Celebration 2019 present On-the-Spot Watercolor Painting 2019 Contest Guideline & Criteria for Judging

1. The competition is open to Grade 7 to 12 students enrolled in any public or private schools/universities citywide.
2. The year's theme "*Kalalangan Kapampangan*".
3. The contestants are required to bring watercolor and regular pencil as a material for the competition. However, water color pencil and marker are not allowed.
4. The organizing committee will provide the paper that will be used.
5. All artworks must be done only on the spot, and must be completed within the allotted time of three (3) hours.
6. All entries will be pre-numbered. No signatures, names, or other identifying marks shall appear on either side of the material of the entry.
7. The entries shall be judged by a board of judges, composed of artists and experts in the field.
8. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable. Any administrative or technical problems that may arise during the contest will be resolved by the organizers, whose decision is also final and irrevocable.
9. The Angeles City Tourism Office (ACTO) will have an exclusive rights for all entries submitted.





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10. Criteria for judging will be as follows:

Relevance to the Theme	30%
Originality	30%
Visual Impact	20%
Creative Use of Material	20%
TOTAL	100%

11. Winners will receive a trophy, certificate and a cash prize each category:

First Prize	Php 5,000 + Trophy
Second Prize	Php 3,000 + Trophy
Third Prize	Php 2,000 + Trophy
