

Theme: "Climate Action for Peace"


Contest Mechanics:

- 1. The contest is open to all Twenty (20) School Divisions around Region 3.
- 2. Each Schools Division will conduct eliminations to select their entries to the regional finals. Each Schools Division shall have one official entry to the regional finals. In case Schools Division eliminations could not be conducted, the Schools Division can endorse only one (1) its official entry for the regional contest.
- 3. Members for each entry must be bona fide students of a public or private Junior High School. The I.D's of the participants must be attached upon the registration.
- **4.** Must be duly endorsed by their respective superintendents/school head. There must be only One Coach in each Division.
- 5. Minimum of participants is 10 and maximum of 15 including instrumentalist and others.
- 6. An Official Registration Form is hereby provided. This must be duly accomplished and sent (scanned in jpeg or PDF format to adelacruz@hau edu.ph) ON OR BEFORE August 30, 2019.
- 7. Instruments to accompany the performance are limited to recycled materials, indigenous instruments, bamboo instruments and the like. Only one acoustic guitar will be allowed during the performance. Amplifiers and microphones and other effects can be used except pyromaterials.
- 8. Contestants must bring their own instrument/s. The organizers reserve the right to scree contestants.
- 9. The jingle lyrics' medium can either be in English or in Filipino, it must be Original Music. Copying of tune or lyrics in an existing song is PROHIBITED.
- 10. Each jingle entry must not exceed 3 minutes. Every exceeding minute corresponds to one (1) point deduction from the total score. A point shall be deducted for every exceeding minute. Use of language should subscribe to the standard rules of decency.
- 11. Lyrics of the original composition or the contest piece must be submitted upon registration on the day of the competition. It must be typewritten on a short bond paper in three (3) copies. It must be written by the student.
- 12. Registration and contest date will be on September 19, 2019.
- 13. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
- 14. The contestants shall be ranked and the top three (3) winners shall be declared as winners and will receive certificates. Winners will be awarded right after the contest.

15. Winning and all other entries shall be the property of the organizers and may be used for other advocacy activities.





- 4. Registration will start at 1:00 pm and the contest proper will start at 1:30-3:00 am
- 5. There will be 2 categories: English and Filipino. Only CURSIVE WRITING will be accepted.
- 6. The essay must be original and must expound on the importance of climate action for peace.
- 7. The organizers will provide yellow paper and ball pens for the contestants.
- 8. All essays shall consist of not less than 400 words but not more than 500 words.
- 9. All essays will automatically become the official property of the HAU School of Education.
- 10. No distinguishing mark or name of the contestant shall appear in the entry.
- 11. Judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
