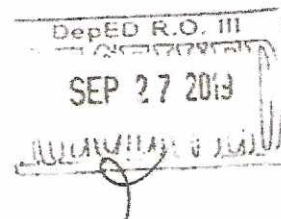

II. Planet over Plastic

Rationale

Spearhead the promotion of environmentally responsible and transformative youth leadership.

In today's global fight over the increasingly hazardous climate change, JUAN-STEP Inc. in support of the UN SDGs 2030 number 13 (Climate Change), 14 (Life Below Water) and 15 (Life on Land) launches its advocacy to educate the youth on the implications of plastic waste to the environment. This is also in consonance with the provisions of the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act (RA 9003). Through our junior leaders, JUAN STEP Inc. seeks to start a cultural transformation towards the proper disposal of plastic wastes as well as the quest to look for more sustainable and environmentally friendly alternatives to plastic usage. This will also further promote the culture of research and development among our learners.

III. Project SEED: Students' Educational Support through Entrepreneurial Development

Rationale

Promote collaboration among junior leaders towards the advancement of various community development programs in the pursuit of nation building

Project SEED aims to provide opportunities to learners particularly the underprivileged and financially challenge individuals to continue and finish their education despite resource constraints such as financial. The program's objectives:

1. Promote entrepreneurial development as the key towards educational support for students by exploring opportunities in line with their skills and expertise
2. Educate the youth on the importance and benefit of entrepreneurship
3. Teach students the importance of financial literacy and management
4. Help students realize the value of saving as a vital key towards financial independence
5. Collaborate with other students towards exploration of entrepreneurial opportunities



Registration Fee: FREE

The program is open to all students from Junior to Senior High Schools and College. There is no Registration Fee to interested students as the organization does not wish to impose added financial constraint to students. The program will not impede the delivery of quality education to learners as the program is designed to be flexible and non-time pressured and puts priority on the studies and other academic requirements first. Parents can help and support their child in the undertaking. For purposes of documentation and background checking, the following are the needed documentary requirements should and individual wishes to join the program:

4. Barangay Certification
5. Curriculum Vitae or Bio data with 2x2 Colored Picture
6. Photocopy of Report Card
