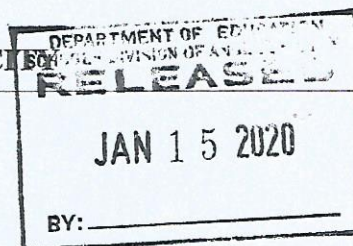

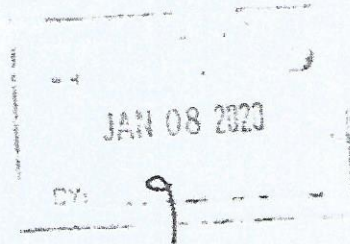

Greetings of Love and Peace from the Science Club Adviser's Association of the Philippines (SCAAP).



1. Participants to the National Children's Science Congress are teachers, pupils and students who were winners in Category A,B and C contests, and coaches from different public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide. These includes pupils from Laboratory Schools and Students attending the Special Science and Gifted Students from SSES/SPED. Non-participants, parents and observers, may join, however they will be charged for their meals and accommodation.
2. Individual category winners in the SIP will receive a medal from the SCAAP and a plaque. The school will also be awarded with a plaque. Team winners will receive 1 medallion from the SCAAP and another medal from the Sponsor.
3. A registration fee of Three Thousand One Hundred (php 3,100.00) of each participant will cover accommodation for meals from dinner of the Day 0 to snacks of Day 3, Judges, honoraria and other incidental expenses of the program, may be chargeable against local funds, school board funds, NGO's fund and other non-DepEd resources and upon the discretion of the School Superintendent subject to the availability of funds according to rules and auditing procedures.
4. All write-ups of the studies (1) one copy only must be submitted to the Secretariat on the said venue on or before January 31, for evaluation.
