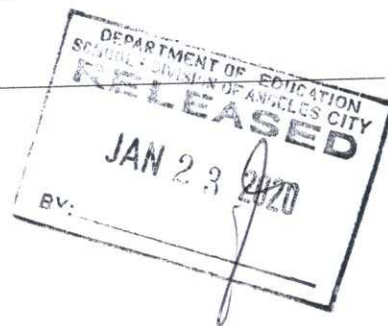

Vision

A. Character building

1. Taekwondo helps to inculcate discipline, leadership, self – confidence and team spirit which are essential for the enhancement of the character of students at an early age.

2. The program covers general Taekwondo rules and regulations, tenets and decorum for the students and parents. By doing so, this will create an awareness and atmosphere of responsibility not just in school but, in their homes as well.

B. City recognition

1. Unlike other team sports where competitions are quite limited and the possibility of winning medals is slim, Taekwondo offers several major and minor competitions involving international, national, regional, district levels and invitational tournaments. Students can participate individually and as a team, thus giving them more opportunities for winning and providing recognition for the school and Angeles City.

2. With an increased number of Taekwondo enthusiast, Angeles City may be used as a venue for which other Taekwondo affiliated schools in Pampanga can hold their promotions, giving way for timely exposure for Angeles city.

3. Angeles City can host friendly matches (dual meets, invitational tournaments) with other regional Taekwondo clubs. Its concept is to periodically invite other regional teams to a friendly match on an agreed venue. The purpose of the meet is to give an opportunity to develop the students individual fighting styles, as well as to promote fellowship and camaraderie among the athletes, parents and coaches.

Grass roots Program:

- To provide a venue to produce potential Taekwondo Elite team players.
- This program starts with Recruitment through enrollees from the Public School year 2019-2020-2021.
- It is open to students male and female from Grade 3-12.
- The training will be handled and supervised by Mr. Ermin Janoras and the Philippine Taekwondo Association affiliated Chapter Angeles City Sports Taekwondo Academy under Janoras Taekwondo Academy.
- It will be 2 hours Once a week or twice a week training depending on the trainers and assigned Assistant trainers and Teacher Coaches available time and day.
- Taekwondo uniforms are not required.
- Training consist of Sparring Techniques and Poomse or forms.
- Upgrading of belts does not apply in this program.
- Php. 50 pesos fee will be collected per student/session for the Assistant trainer as allowance for their service and to fund additional trainers to closely supervise the training and to purchase equipment necessary for the development of the participants.
- The program will also prepare our participants for our next program the 2020 Free Milo Summer Taekwondo Workshop and Promotion test to upgrade their belt.
- This program aims to enhance the fighting skills of potential athletes which will be chosen to represent their school in local and regional competitions.
- The schedule will be discussed with the assigned Teacher Coach of each school.
- Only appointed Trainers listed above is allowed to conduct training in these schools.
- The trainers listed above are resident and homeowners of Angeles City with Baranggay clearances to prove they are legitimate Home owner and local.
