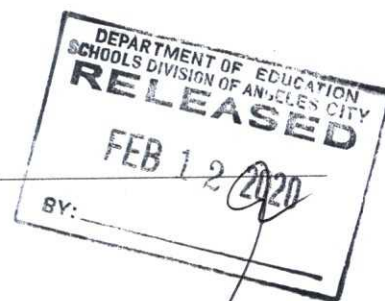

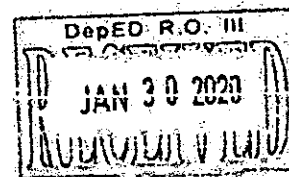

The following registration fee will be collected to cover meals during the conference, kits, conference materials and certificates:

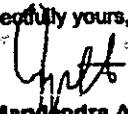
