

The Taekwondo Workshop is free to all participating Public School Teachers. Each Public Schools of Angeles City will have one or two representative. The Program consists of proper Court Management, Officiating, Referee Seminar, and a Promotion test. Certificates, Referee Handbook and White belt review Handbook will be given to our Participants for free. The budget of the course will come from the ACSO Department and will be supervised by Angeles City Certified PTA instructors, together with Region 3 Chairman Sir Dauphin Punzalan and Referee Chairman Sir Rodeo Casangkapan. After this workshop the teachers will then be given specific instructions to conduct Taekwondo clubs in their respective schools. We will help supervise these teachers to teach their students the proper training and be able to undergo promotions to upgrade their ranks. Teachers are then required to attend our PTA refresher courses to review and enhance their training skills. All Schools in this program will be under the supervision of the Philippine Taekwondo Association affiliated chapter Angeles City Sports Taekwondo Academy.

# **Angeles City Sports Taekwondo Academy**



Grass roots Development Program by the Angeles City Sports Office Acknowledge by the Department of Education Angeles City Division Office

\*Angeles City Sports Taekwondo Academy is an affiliated chapter of the Philippine Taekwondo Association, and by the Angeles City Sports Office, whose function is to help DEPED, train public school students as well as to give accreditation to our Public School Teachers.

# Stages of the Program:

- \*Public School Teachers will undergo a Three day Workshop which includes Referee Seminar, Officiating and Proper Court Management on the 1<sup>st</sup> day, Poomse review from Foundation form 1 and 2, Taeguk 1 to 8 and Koryo to Taebek on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day.
- 2. On the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of the Workshop, Public School Teachers will then take a Promotion test to upgrade their current belt.
- 3. Public School Teachers who underwent a 3 day Workshop will then undergo a Modular Taekwondo Training. This Module is divided into 5 stages. 1<sup>st</sup> Module is from White belt to Yellow belt, 2<sup>nd</sup> Module is from Yellow belt to Blue belt, 3<sup>rd</sup> module is from Blue to Red, 4<sup>th</sup> module from Red to Brown, 5<sup>th</sup> Module is from Brown to Black belt.
- 4. During the Modular training, the participants will be given specific Instructions from the ACSTA to conduct Taekwondo program to their students in their respective Schools.
- Students under their tutelage will also undergo the same Modular program to upgrade their ranks and will be frequently monitored by the ACSTA to make sure they are properly trained and prepared for promotions.
- 6. All participants, Public School Teachers, Public School Students will be under the Chapter ACSTA and their Head Instructor Mr. Ermin Janoras.
- 7. Public School Teachers who finished the 5 Modular Taekwondo Training will then apply and register for the PTA Instructors Course/Referee Course.
- 8. Public School Teachers who passed the PTA Instructor Course is now an Accredited Taekwondo Coach/Trainer of the PTA only in their respective School.
- Public School Teachers who did not or haven't finished the Modular program can still conduct Taekwondo Clubs in their respective Schools as an official representative and is under the guidance of ACSTA.
- 10. Public School Students supervised by these Teachers is under ACSTA.
- 11. This program is applicable to Public School Teachers/Students only. Private School Teachers/students are not allowed to join in this program. This program will also prepare them for the Free Milo Summer Clinic for Public Schools Scheduled on the month of April to May and 2020 Mayors Cup Angeles City Taekwondo Championships (2020 Mayor Carmelo (Pogi) Lazatin Taekwondo Competitions) for Public School Developmental on May 30, 2020 and Angeles City Open Championship on August 2, 2020.

# **Participants**

- 1. All Public Schools within Angeles city must have one or two representing Coach/Trainer to participate in this program.
- 2. Team Managers for Taekwondo (Deped)
- 3. Angeles City PTA Instructors (Residents of Angeles City with Baranggay Clearance and Voters Identification).

#### Arrangements

- 1. The Workshop for 3 days will be handled by Referee Chairman of Region 3 Mr. Rodeo Casangkapan and Regional Management Committee, Region 3 Chairman Mr. Dauphin Punzalan.
- 2. This Workshop includes Visual Aids, Handouts, LPSS Electronic Sensing System and Certificates.
