#### **COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM 2025**




To: School Principals and Administrators of Public and Private Elementary, Junior, and Senior High Schools

- 1. The Boy Scout of the Philippines Angeles City Council shall conduct Council Scout Youth Forum with the Theme: "Scouts for Peace and Sustainable Development" on March 7-9, 2025, at the BSP Training Center, Sto. Domingo, Angeles City.
- 2. The Objective of the activity are as follows:
  - a. to help scouts acquire the experiences and skills necessary to express their views and opinion constructively, particularly in matters that affect them;
  - b. to provide an opportunity for young people to discuss matters affecting the implementation of the scouting program;
  - c. to provide "feedback" to the government bodies and Standing Committee of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines on the views of the youth on Scouting and other matters that have been referred for them for discussion;
  - d. to enable the scouts to effectively communicate their needs and aspiration on present issues and to discover ways to get involved in community service and nation-building; and
  - e. to provide scouts with better understanding of the differences among people (as result of shared experiences) to help them establish effective relationships with others.
- 3. The Participants must be:
  - a. a registered scout;
  - b. have a neckerchief and slide; and
  - c. have a parental consent.

Likewise, the participants are required to bring the following.

- 1. Plate/Mug/ Fork/Spoon and Glass;
- 2. Toiletries Kit / Off Lotion;
- 3. Blanket / extra cloth; and
- 4. Dinner Pack.


