This participation is a civic and social responsibility in support of national programs and activities commemorating Philippine Independence.

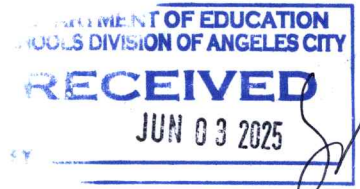


