- Pursuant to the aforementioned Proclamation, the 21st annual observance of the National Crime Prevention Week (NCPW) will be held on September 1-7, 2015 with the theme. Krimen ay Tuldukan, Karapatan ay Igalang!
- 2. The NCPW observance this year is geared towards adopting the Community and Service-Oriented Policing (CSOP) System, aimed at building collaborative partnership between the law enforcement agencies, local executives and community, promoting peace and order, ensuring public safety as well as strengthening the local government capability for the effective delivery of basic services to the citizenty.
- In order to bolster a system of coordination and cooperation, the units in the Philippine National Police (PNP) are directed to coordinate with the local executives and the community to identify issues and concerns in the area on how basic services can be delivered more effectively through joint programs and projects, which should be implemented by means of collaboration and cooperation and complementation of funds, personnal and logistics.
- 4. Recognizing that keeping the communities safe is not just the responsibility of the police, the objectives of the coming celebration are as follows:
 - Strengthen the support of local chief executives in crime prevention and community policing;

communities and create secure and safe environment through smentation of OSOF System.

- Memorandum to all PNP Regional Provincial. City and Municipal Police Offices and stations/precincts to undertake crime prevention projects and activities in their respective areas of jurisdiction in coordination with NAPOLCOM Regional and Provincial Offices, to include the conduct of community dialogues to identify issues and concerns on peace and order, and public safety as well as effective delivery of basic services to the community.
