- The DepEd Division of Angeles City will hold A DIVISION RAMPA 2014, which is the highlight of the Opening Program of 2014 Education Week Celebration at SM Clark on December 9, 2014 from 10: 00 A.M. to 12:00 Noon. This will showcase talents and creativity in terms of fashion and creation using indigenous and recycled materials. This event aims to:
  - promote the use of indigenous materials
  - showcase individual creativity and admirable imagination
  - value of perseverance and patience
  - show importance and affordability of locally available materials

1. *The participants in this competition are students who have won in the district level competition for best gowns made of recycled and indigenous materials.*

2. *Guidelines for the contest:*

1. There shall be one pair of students per district for the elementary level and 1 pair for the secondary level. There will be a total of 5 pairs (5 males and 5 females) participating in the contest.

2. The theme of the costumes will be Filipiniana

3. The costumes to be worn on the event must be made with indigenous/recycled materials. The designer or a representative is required to discuss the details of the costume during the event proper.

4. Designers are prohibited from using fire hazardous chemicals , flammable substances, or similar materials to enhance the costumes.

5. The participants are required to submit the costing of materials used in the costumes with the description.

6. A selected panel of judges will judge the contest. Judging will be done during the event based on the criteria indicated below.

7. The decision of the judges once announced is final and irrevocable.

8. Awards to be bestowed are the following:

- Most inexpensive costume
  - Best in Costume (male and female)
