1. As per **DepEd Memorandum No. 222, S 2013**, the administration of the National Achievement Test (NAT) for SY 2013 – 2014 shall be on the following dates.

- 2. Only private elementary and secondary schools with permit to operate from the Department shall be included in the conduct of the test.
- 3. There will be a division orientation of all school heads on the conduct of the 2014 National Achievement Test as follows:

- 5. The TEPT-PST shall be administered to all **Grade 1, 2, 5 and 6 public school teachers** with permanent positions in the division. It shall be given by cluster, all Saturdays and Sundays starting March 2014 to June 2014. The National Education and Testing and Research Center (NETRC) shall provide the clustering of regions and shall announce it through an advisory.
- 6. All school heads are required to bring the list of teachers who will serve as room examiners (RE) and room supervisors (RS) to other schools.
- 7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this memorandum is desired.
