TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON CONDUCTING SCIENCE INVESTIGATORY PROJECT

- 1. A Three-day Training Workshop on Conducting Science Investigatory Project will be held at the Gabaldon Bldg., Angeles City on August 13-14, and 15, 2015. The schedule of the activities during the training including the exposure trip to the Philippine Science HS-Clark is herewith attached.
- 2. The objectives of the said training-workshop are as follows:
 - update the teachers on the processes and products of mathematical investigations and science investigatory projects;
 - reinforce their skills and competencies in problem solving and in critical, creative, and ethical reflection;
 - enhance teachers' competence in proving conjectures;
 - share models of mathematical investigations conducted by students; and
 - discuss the guidelines and skills necessary in doing collaborative research projects using the multidisciplinary approach with students.
- 3. Participants to this activity are:
 - 52 School Science Coordinators
 - 107 SSES Science Teachers and Students
 - 59 STE Science Teachers and Students
- 4. A registration fee of *Five Hundred Sixty Pesos* (*P560.00*) shall be charged per participant to cover the expenses for the food for 2 days including training materials chargeable against the SSES/STE Funds/School MOOE subject to the usual auditing and accounting procedures. The expenses that maybe incurred during Day 3 exposure trip to the Philippine Science HS-Clark maybe charged against school local funds.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
