Misasanmetung a Galo, Para Keng Balen Angeleno A Dance Workshop Aligned to K-12 Program

To: All Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads

- 1. The Teachers and Choreographers Dance Associations (TACDA) will conduct a 3-day dance workshop on August 7-9, 2015 at Marquee Mall, Angeles City. This workshop aims to provide a venue for teachers, choreographers, and dance club moderators to explore different dance genres and find their relevance in the implementation of their professions.:
- 2. The objectives of the workshop are:
 - Discuss the relevance of several sample dances to the K-12 Curriculum for PE;
 - Enhance teachers' dance creativity as they experience proper dance term technicalities and precision of dance steps and movements in preparation for school dance productions and competitions;
 - c. Promote nationalism and patriotism through Philippine folk dances.
- 3. The target participants for the activity are elementary and secondary Physical Education (PE) teachers, dance teachers, choreographers, and dance club moderators.
- 4. A registration fee of two hundred pesos (P200) will be collected from each participant to cover the operational expenses and handouts for the workshop.
