2016 CENTRAL LUZON REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

TO: **Curriculum Implementation Division School Governance and Operation Division** Heads of Public and Private Elementary and Secondary/Integrated Schools All Others Concerned

- 1. The CENTRAL LUZON REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION (CLRAA) Meet will be held at Bulacan Sports Complex, Sta. Isabel, Malolos City, Bulacan on February 7-12, 2016.
- 2. The CLRAA will be hosted by the Department of Education Regional Office 3 with the assistance of the Provincial Government of Bulacan and DepEd Schools Division of Bulacan.
- 3. The objectives of the 2016 CLRAA Meet are: 1) to select athletes who will represent the region in the 2016 Palarong Pambansa; 2) to inculcate discipline, teamwork and excellence; and 3) to promote sportsmanship and camaraderie among the athletes.
- 4. The sports event to be played are: Archery, Arnis, Athletics, Badminton, Baseball, Basketball, Boxing, Chess, Football, Gymnastics, Sepak Takraw, Softball, Swimming, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, Tennis, Volleyball, Special Olympics. Billiard, Futsal and Sepak Takraw Girls shall be a demonstration sports.
- 5. The technical guidelines stipulated in Enclosure No. 3 "Technical Guidelines of the Different Sports Events, Including Demonstration Sports and Special Games" of DepEd Memorandum No. 39 s. 2015 shall remain in effect unless otherwise amended or revised.
- 6. Prior to our participation in the said meet there will be a pre-departure meeting of all coaches, asst. coaches, chaperons, trainers, screening committee, recorders, and officiating officials on Thursday, February 4, 2016 at 3:00 in the afternoon at the Angeles Elementary School Covered Court, Angeles City. The meeting will focus on the preparation of Angeles City participation to CLRAA Meet 2016.
- 7. Departure for Paombong Central School, Paombong, Bulacan will be on February 6, 2016. The Angeles City Delegation will assemble at Angeles Elementary School at 7:00 a.m. and will leave at exactly 8:00 a.m.

- 8. Coaches, Asst. Coaches, Chaperons, and Trainers should at all times uphold the in loco-parenti in place of a parent). They should provide adequate supervision on athletes and ensure that they observe on discipline, honesty, cleanliness and orderliness, sportsmanship and camaraderie (RM 194 s.2014)
- A refresher course for all officiating officials will be on February 6, 2016 at 2:00 PM at the Bulacan Sports Complex. All concerned are required to attend the said refresher course.
- Solidarity meeting for all coaches, officiating officials and tournament managers will be on February 7, 2016 at 8:00 a.m. at the Bulacan Sports Complex, Sta. Isabel, Malolos City, Bulacan.
- 11. Opening Program will be on December 7, 2014 at Bulacan Sports Complex to be followed by Governor's Night at the Hiyas Convention Center.
- 12. There will be a search for the Most Disciplined, Most Organized and Cleanest delegation. As such, everybody is expected to be responsible for the upkeep of their respective quarters and surroundings.
- 13. Athletes, assistant coaches, trainers and officials are advised to bring their own eating utensils, beddings, toiletries and flashlights.
- 14. School Heads are advised to make necessary measures to avoid disruption of classes of the teachers/coaches/chaperons/trainers. Pupil/student-athletes should be excused from their classes and be given take home lessons.
- 15. Service Credits shall be granted to teachers-coaches/chaperons/trainers, technical and officiating officials who will serve during the CLRAA 2016 as stipulated in DECS Order No. 53 s.2003.
- Enclosed is the list of the Angeles City Delegation.
- 17. Expenses during the regional meet such as allowances of athletes, coaches, chaperons, trainers and technical officials and other related expenditures shall be charged to Special Education Fund (SEF) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.
