

## Reorientation Training and Write shop on the Implementation of MTB/MLE

- 1. This is to announce the conduct of Reorientation and Training Write shop on the Implementation of MTB/MLE on May 17-19, 2016 at the Gabaldon Building Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
- 2. This activity is in response to the need of strengthening the implementation of the MTB/MLE Program in this division which was determined from the results of supervision, monitoring and evaluation conducted in the previous school year. The need to refresh key implementers on the guidelines on the implementation of MTB/MLE as enclosed on DepEd Order 16 s. 2012 is a must and all other related issues and concerns relevant to the attainment of the goals and objectives of the program shall also be dealt comprehensively in the said endeavor.
