



ADDENDUM TO DIVISION MEMO. 84 s. 2016 BRIGADA ESKWELA 2016

- 1. In connection to the Division Memorandum No, 84, s 2016 entitled Brigada Eskwela 2016, please be informed of the following additional information:
 - a. The arrangement of the vehicles for the motorcade and the route flow are provided in Enclosure numbers 1 and 2, respectively. Personnel from Angeles City National Trade School will assist the parking of vehicles at the venue for the opening program.
 - b. School Heads and Brigada Eskwela Coordinators are advised to wear the prescribed Brigada Eskwela T-shirt during the motorcade (see enclosure no. 3 for the print design). All schools are requested to display some balloons on their respective vehicles. The balloon colors for the district schools are as follows:
 - i. North District Blue
 - ii. East District Yellow
 - iii. West District Maroon
 - iv. South District Green
 - v. Secondary/Integrated Schools Red
 - c. All school heads are requested to submit the names of at least two male motor riders (those with motorcycle) to be Marshalls for the motorcade on or before May 18, 2016 at the Social Mobilization and Networking Unit. All teacher Marshalls shall have a meeting on May 20, 2016 at the Library Hub, Division Office.
 - d. For the purpose of uniform labor rate, the labor rate rendered of volunteers in the Brigada Eskwela to be indicated in the report is P300 per day or Php 37.50 per hour.
 - e. The template for the tarpaulin is provided in Enclosure number 4. All schools are advised to pick up their 3' x 4' Brigada Eskwela tarpaulin at Php 150.00 from TCM located in Villa Siete, Sto. Cristo, Angeles City. The tarpaulin is expected to be hung up visibly for the public in their respective schools.
