1. In line with Presidential Proclamation No. 1906, s. 2009, declaring October as Indigenous

- Peoples' Month, the Division of Angeles City will be conducting a consultative planning, community engagement and immersion for Ayta Mag-Antsi on October 26-27, 2016 at Sitio Target Extension School, Sapangbato, Angeles City.
- 2. The objectives of the activities are:
 - a) To build and strengthen the environment for long term dialogue and partnership and sustained support from both DepEd and the communities themselves.
 - b) To recognize the Indigenous Learning System and Indigenous Knowledge System and Practices of the Ayta Community.
 - c) To create awareness of the different activities to be implemented for the preparation of the indigenization and localization of their curriculum.
 - d) To showcase Indigenous Peoples cultural resources, practices, rituals, chants, music, songs and dances, stories, traditional arts and crafts and indigenous games
- 3. The participants to the consultative planning, community engagement and immersion are the CID, SGOD, Principals and Teachers with IP Learners, Elders and Community Members and selected pupils.
- 4. Meals, travel and other expenses relative to this activity shall be charged to IPEd Program Support Fund (PSF) 2016 subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
