REGIONAL ORIENTATION ON THE KAPAMPANGAN ORTHOGRAPHY

TO: Division Coordinator of MTB-MLE Public Elementary School Heads MTB-MLE District Coordinators Teachers of MTB- MLE, K-3

- The Department of Education, Regional Office III will conduct an Orientation on the New Kapampangan Orthography to the four divisions in the locality of Pampanga. The orientation will be delivered in four (4) clusters at the Benigno Hall of the Department of Education, Region III, Maimpis, City of San Fernando, Pampanga. The schedule assigned to this division is November 9, 2016, from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.
- 2. The objectives of the orientation are to:
 - a. Equip the participants with the necessary understanding on the new Kapampangan Orthography;
 - Enhance their teaching skills and methodologies in the teaching of the Mother Tongue in Kinder to Grade 3;
 - c. Guide them in crafting their daily lessons in MTB aligned to the new orthography;
 - d. Design an action plan for the District School Learning Action Cell (DSLAC) to discuss the Kapampangan Orthography for all the K to Grade 3 Teachers.
- 3. Participants in this orientation are the Division MTB-MLE Coordinator, four (4) District Coordinators and one (1) teacher in each grade level from Kinder to Grade 3 of the schools specified on the attached list. Each school will be sending four (4) teachers per school. However the schools where the designated District MTB-MLE Coordinators are assigned will be sending five (5) participants.
- 4. The total number of expected participants from this division is one hundred one (101), composed of 100 teachers and the MTB-MLE Division Coordinator, Dr. Agnes G. Manabat.
- 5. The food for the participants, resource speakers, regional supervisors, and CLMD staff shall be charged against the Regional MOOE while travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- Participants are expected to be at the venue at 8:00 a.m. for the opening program. First meal to be served will be the morning snacks.
- Necessary arrangement on the class schedule of all participating teachers shall be the responsibility of the school heads ensuring that time on tasks on the teaching – learning shall not be sacrificed.
- 9. Immediate dissemination and compliance to this memorandum is expected.
