


- 1. Please be informed that there will be a Division Research Congress on December 2, 2016 at the Sto. Rosario Conference Hall.



DIVISION RESEARCH CONGRESS 2016

- Education program supervisors, school heads, classroom teachers, ALS coordinators and teachers, graduate school students, interested research non-teaching personnel are qualified to present their papers to the Division Research Congress. Their research papers should be anchored on the priority themes indicated in the Basic Education Research Agenda, to wit:
 - I. Teaching and Learning
 - II. Child Protection
 - III. Human Resource Development
 - IV. Governance
- The findings generated from the identified research theme should yield evidence-based actions ensuring effective, transparent and engaging governance.
- The research manuscript must undergo review and evaluation by the Division Research Evaluation and Technical Review Committee. The full blown research must not have been presented in the previous international and national conferences, and that the paper follows the APA format 6th Edition.
- 4. Oral Presenters should prepare a powerpoint presentation of not more than 15 slides following the structured format:
 - ✓ Title and the Researcher
 - ✓ Rationale
 - ✓ Statement of the Problem
 - ✓ Method
 - ✓ Participants
 - ✓ Instrument
 - ✓ Statistical Treatment
 - ✓ Findings (Tables only)
 - ✓ Conclusion and Recommendations
- 5. Oral presentations shall be guided by the following mechanics.
 - Presentation shall last for 10-15 minutes with 5 minutes for open forum.
 - II. The copy of the powerpoint presentation should be given to the Conference Secretariat before the program proper starts.
 - III. Prepare at least 5 hard copies for the evaluator's copy and shall submit one to the conference secretariat.
 - IV. Oral Presenter should come in business / corporate attire.
 - V. Bring laptop, extension cord and the like during the presentation.
